
New Britannia Leisure Centre

Update for August

On the Leisure Centre this month the external façade is now almost complete and as you will have seen most of the large glossy panels have now been installed. Internally, the new areas are being formed with the first fix walls. The main pool has been filled with water ready for the structural test.

Planned works for September

The cladding works will almost be complete, roof level mesh will continue. mechanical and electrical works will continue, tiling will commence on site. The temporary energy centre will be delivered to the south elevation of the leisure centre.



City of London Academy, Shoreditch Park

Update for August

This month on the Academy project the level 4 clerestory roof pre-cast cladding panel installation has commenced and the pre-cast cladding is now almost complete on level 3 and level 4. Window install has commenced to level 2, drylining works have continued with plasterboard installation to level ground and level 1. The M&E installation continues on all levels and the benchmark classroom is nearing completion. For anyone who has passed the site recently and seen our tower cranes with a wrap around them, we have installed this around the crane mast to provide weather protection to the atrium areas while the cranes are in place.

Planned works for September

The precast façade will continue, you will also see windows being installed to close up the external walls. The roof covering installation will continue. Internally we will continue with the new services installation throughout the building



Community Engagement Mentoring alongside the Department for Work and Pensions

Hannah Cowell has been contacted by the DWP to help work with young people following coronavirus as it has been known to make 18-24-year olds across the capital feel disillusioned and disenfranchised from research undertaken.

The aim of the call was to help reach out to strategic partners and employers who will be able to help give advice.

We will be offering some coaching to local Hackney residents through this scheme which involves a 2-3-hour session with a group of young people who are interested in a career in construction. Throughout the session we will be working on self-confidence, what to expect when arriving at an interview and the selection process on apprenticeships. We hope by participating in the mentor circle scheme to inspire young people into thinking more seriously about what the construction industry has to offer.




