New Britannia Leisure Centre

What we have done so far?

The basement structure for the pool plant in the new Leisure Centre has been completed along with the new foundations for the steel frame.

What's next?

We will shortly commence installing the steel frame structure for the Leisure Centre along with precast concrete floors. You will shortly see these works commence above the hoardings. These work will continue until February next year.



City of London Academy, Shoreditch Park

What we have done so far?

We progressed with the new basement and ground floor slabs for the new School building. We are also currently forming the new concrete stair and lift cores through the new building.

What's next?

The Steel frame for the new school will commence early December and be complete in April next year. Precast concrete floor slabs will also be installed into the new structure as works progress.



Service Installation

What we have done so far?

All super trench installations have now been completed for the whole of the Britannia Hackney Sites and we have completed this on time and ahead of schedule.

What's next?

We have one more piece of work to complete to connect the final services for the Colville Estate at the beginning of the year 2020.

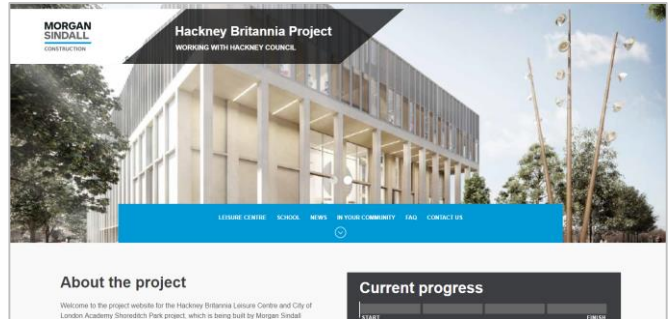

We have now completed a site visit with a company called Wheels for Wellbeing. This is part of our ongoing commitment to work with TfL and Street scene to ensure that our construction site boundary is easily accessible for all pedestrian users. Wheels for Wellbeing main focus is wheelchair cycling and ensuring cycle lanes provided are adequate for this alongside promotion of how to allow inclusion for all wheelchair users Michael Barratt from Transport for London. The visit was of real benefit as the audit included using a wheelchair to experience the difficulties which are faced and also highlighted some areas that could be improved for the visually impaired.
